The Challenge in the Health Sector

In highly challenging circumstances, like in **Syria**, and in addition to the many challenges that face the health sector, hospitals have loads of broken equipment, incubators, oxygen concentrators and other valuable and life-saving equipment that is doing nothing because parts are broken.







Our Intervention

This region-centered manufacture of spare parts for medical devices needing repair specifically includes assessing broken medical devices and equipment; it prioritizes, repairs and restores critical healthcare equipment in **Syria** through newly created replacement parts or replacement products.



Innovative Approach

Evidence from the evaluation showed that **Field Ready** introduced a new and innovative approach which enabled people in need to access quality and timely healthcare services.






Better/Impact

- Medical professionals believe these patients would not have been helped if these devices stayed out of service.
- 89.5% of surveyed facilities saw enhanced patientcare abilities as a direct result of the project.

Hospital's ability to address Medical Device Maintenance needs







- A Sample of 83 devices.
- Comparison of number of working days spent to repair same device with same fault.
- Our innovative approach is <u>44%</u> faster than traditional methods.
- Quicker repairs translate to more lifesaving services provided to patients.

- Sample size: 83 medical devices.
- Comparison of cost included materials, transportation, and staff/labor costs.
- Our innovation was found 66% cheaper than traditional methods.
- **90%** of surveyed facilities confirmed that our approach is more cost-effective.
